

# Arran END to ENDuro

Route Information + 3.gpx files  
swap between these 3 files to follow the  
whole route or use as separate day rides.

**78 miles Total Miles**  
**44 miles North to South**  
**34 miles South to North**  
**8500ft Total Climbing**

*This route description starts and finishes  
at Brodick Ferry Terminal.*

Follow the A841 from Brodick to  
Lochranza (indicated in orange), a good  
quick warm up to arrive at the official  
start of the End to End at Lochranza  
Hostel. 🍴 ☕ 🛏

Head out of Lochranza on technical single  
track, passing Laggan Cottage eventually  
reaching Sannox. 🍴 ☕

Short road ride through Corrie 🍴 ☕ 🛏  
before ascending the Maol Don trails on  
the flanks of Goatfell above the Castle,  
eventually dropping back into Brodick.  
🍴 ☕ 🛏

Climb the road out of Brodick then the  
minor road through Corriegills, turning to  
rough track before heading up and over  
Clauchlands ridge to meet the A841. Cross  
this to then descend into Lamlash village.  
🍴 ☕ 🛏

Leave Lamlash for a short road ride to  
Dyemill - Arran's Bike Park, steep bermed  
trails, a rock garden and a pump track, all  
with a wee Hub centre, small but  
beautifully formed by the Arran High  
School MTB club.

Once finished at Dyemill follow the  
trails above Whiting Bay until reaching  
the A841 and a short section of road to  
Eas Mor. 🍴 ☕

Climb out of Eas Mor on trails and forest  
road, eventually dropping into Kilmory  
village, where Kilmory Hall is the official  
finish of the End to End. 🍴 ☕ 🛏

To finish back at the Brodick Ferry  
Terminal, follow the many different and  
exciting trails and single track (marked in  
Orange), back through Dyemill and  
Lamlash to Brodick.

*To ride the whole 78 miles in one day is a  
huge undertaking, but it can also be easily  
split down into more achievable multi day  
sections.*
